

SPECIAL REGULARISATION 2026: EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW

WHAT IS REGULARISATION?



A **one-year residence and work permit**.



You may work once you have been notified that the procedure has begun.



Families in an irregular situation may regularise their status together with their minor children or adult children with disabilities.



Deadline for submitting the application
From 16 April to 30 June

YOU ARE ELIGIBLE FOR REGULARISATION IF:



You applied for international protection **before 1 January 2026**.



You have been living in Spain since **before 1 January 2026** and can demonstrate one of the following:



You have been self-employed or employed by others, or you have a **contract or a job offer**.



You live with your family unit, with **minor children or adult children with disabilities, or with your parents or parents-in-law**.



You are in a **situation of vulnerability**.

WHAT DO YOU NEED?



Valid identity documents, such as a passport, registration certificate or travel document.



No criminal record in your country of origin or in the countries where you have lived during the 5 years prior to entering Spain.



Proof that you have lived in Spain for the 5 months prior to submitting your application (e.g. registration in the municipal register, utility bills, medical reports, etc.).



Payment of the application fee.

HOW DO YOU APPLY?



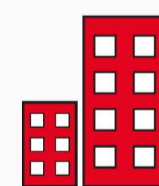
Online, using a **digital certificate**.



In person, by booking a free appointment at designated post offices, Social Security or Immigration offices.



Through a partner organisation (free of charge) or with the assistance from lawyers, social security consultants or administrative agents.
